Special Interest Plant Of The Month April 2018


PLANT NAME: Stenoglottis longifolia

OWNER'S NAME Ian Kidd

JUDGE'S COMMENT:

Housing The plant is grown in a shade house under 50% Shade cloth, in a mixed collection with mainly Cattleyas.

Watering: Twice a week in summer; every one to two weeks in winter, with daily misting most days in summer.



Potting Medium: Brunnings or similar potting mix with about 30% coarse sand added, ie. a Typical terrestrial mix.

Other Cultural Comments: The species is one of a small genus found in Eastern South Africa. It is Strongly deciduous losing all of its leaves in Winter (the dry season), when no water or Fertilizer should be used.
