Special Interest Plant Of The Month

April 2018

PLANT NAME: *Stenoglottis longifolia*

OWNER'S NAME Ian Kidd

JUDGE'S COMMENT: .

Housing The plant is grown in a shade house under 50% Shade cloth, in a mixed collection with mainly Cattleyas.

Watering : Twice a week in summer; every one to two weeks in winter, with daily misting most days in summer.

Feeding Program : Fertilizer used is the same as for Cattleyas: high in N in spring/early summer ,but minimal feeding in winter (see comments below)

Potting Medium : Brunnings or similar potting mix with about 30% coarse sand added, ie. a Typical terrestrial mix. .

Other Cultural Comments : The species is one of a small genus found in Eastern South Africa. It is Strongly deciduous losing all of its leaves in Winter (the dry season), when no water or Fertilizer should be used.
